


Harford 250 Showcase – Frequently Asked Questions

General Information

What is the Harford 250 Showcase?

A two-day event to highlight the arts, culture, people and history of Harford County and the Grand Opening of the year-long celebration of the establishment of Harford County.

What is the First Look?

On Friday, March 31, guests age 21 and older are invited to an exclusive come-and-see event, to tour over 40 displays, meet jazz professional and Harford County native, Kim Waters, enjoy an evening of jazz music provided by the C. Milton Wright Jazz Band, taste culinary treats prepared by the HCC students and chefs, and drink beer and wine. Stroll through the art gallery featuring works by award-winning Harford professional artists and vote on the People's Choice for amateur art in several categories.

What should we wear to the First Look?

The dress code is 21st century business attire OR party clothes from your favorite era of the 20th century.

How much are First Look tickets and where can I buy them?

Tickets are \$75 each and include hors d'oeuvres and two drink tickets. There is a cash bar. Tickets may be purchased at www.harford250.org or <https://harford.universitytickets.com/w/event.aspx?id=2014>. Be sure to bring a driver's license or similar proof-of-age to the First Look. Tickets purchased through HCC can be printed out or stored electronically on your phone.

Will tickets be sold on-site?

Yes. The HCC ticket office is open both days.

What is the Family Fun Day?

On Saturday, April 1, everyone is invited to Come and See about Harford! We have over 40 displays where you can learn more about arts, cultural, historical, and service groups in the county. Weather-permitting there is an outdoor display of historic fire trucks. View the art gallery and vote in the People's Choice contest for amateur artists. There is live, local entertainment all day long! And you are invited to wear a costume from an era in Harford County history (1638-present, Maryland).

How much are Family Fun Day tickets and where can I get them?

Adult tickets are \$5 each. Tickets for HCC students and everyone under 17 are free, but everyone needs a ticket to enter.
